<u>Group 1</u> (Graham Terry, Gwyn Carwardine, Gill Terry, Colin Cracknell, Kathy Cracknell, Denis Bingham)

- Rotate building to relate better to cricket pitch i.e. have it running more parallel to existing drainage ditch;
- Door to link stage to meeting room;
- Omit corridor to stage and make the door from main hall to side of the stage a single leaf so that the stage could be made wider;
- More windows to be provided and canopy of south side of the main hall.

<u>Group 2</u> (Ann Spencer, Lyndsey Waddington, Fiona Bickerton, Don Smith, Clara Thompson, John Thompson)

- Provide external access to new sports pavilion and changing rooms;
- Type of surface for car park;
- Concern about running building over drainage ditch solution would be to re-route e.g. culvert it and run it on the cricket pitch side of the building into ditch behind current sports pavilion;
- Increase size of kitchen by absorbing planned storage area;
- More windows on south side of the main hall;
- Storage area under stage;
- Need to keep sports area and main hall separate.

- More natural light for main hall on south side extend awning;
- Need to provide low maintenance building and traditional in appearance to fit into landscape;

- Building orientation is fine;
