

Hadlow Down Community Centre Survey, July 2023

Hadlow Down Community Centre (HDCC) is a not-for-profit organisation created to drive forward the provision of a new Village Hall & Sports Pavilion for the benefit of all the villagers of Hadlow Down. The Committee is comprised of a group of residents who are trustees and volunteers. Our members are Bob Lake (Chair) John Thompson (Treasurer) Janet Tourell (Secretary) Fiona Shafer, Sarah Prall, Mandy Chapman and Rob Prall.

We aim to promote community spirit by involving all residents of the parish, with the intention of meeting the challenges ahead. In addition, we hope to encourage participation of all individuals or groups from within Hadlow Down or, who have links with the community, in the building and use of the new Hall & Pavilion.

The new building will be *located at the Playing Field, and will include a **Larger Hall, Meeting Rooms, Kitchen and Toilets. The Pavilion will include male and female changing facilities, showers, storage, club room and bar. There will be parking for 43 cars, including 5 spaces for disabled users, 10 bicycle parking spaces and 20% of the car parking spaces will be fitted with electric charging points.

- * The current Village Hall is located on Hut Lane
- *The current Pavilion is located at the Playing Field, School Lane
- **The new hall area = 180m2 the existing hall area = 116m2

Put simply, we hope the new building will become the beating heart of our community, set in the beautiful surroundings of the Playing Field.

We want to put the needs of our community at the centre of this project and future proof our plans with your input.
